Longtime *Pittsburgh Courier* editor mentored many journalists, dies at 72

Ulish Hay Carter, a longtime munaging editor for the New Pitsburgh Gourier who impacted many Pittsburgh iournalists, has died.

Mr. Carrier, 72, died July 12 at his home on the North Side, according to his younger sister, Patricia Arm Carter-Lewis, of Woodstock, Ga.

Mr. Carter spent more than 30 years of his over 40-year career with the renowned Black newspaper, leading the sports, entertainment and metro news sections before he extined as managing editor in March 2017. He was replaced by Bobert "Rob" Taylor, the Courier's current managing editor.

Born in Huntington, Total, on July 29, 1950, Mr. Cartur sport his formative years in Champaign, III, where he played on the basketball team at Certermial High School and graduated in 1969.

At Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, he majored in journalism; radio-TV and minored in Black history.

In a 2011 interview with the Granier, Mr. Carter said he was fully committed from the beginning to working in Black journalism. After graduation, his job choices were narrowed down to the New Pittsburgh Granier, Bultimore/Washington AFRO and the Chicago Defender.

His joined the Courier in 1975 as a sportswriter, though he really wanted to write the state of the Police of the

After six years in sports and entertainment at the Courier, Mr. Carter transitioned to the metro news dosk and became managing editor. He served in that position from 1996 to 2004 and, after a fear-year histor, from 2008 to 2017.

Retired Courier sportswriter fiddle Jefferies became sports editor when Mr. Carter was promoted to managing selfore.

"Ulish had replaced Bill Nates, and I followed Ulish. It was a special time at the Gracier," Mr. Jefferies said.

"Ulish was very patient and taught me the intricacies of newspaper layout and dosign. I'll always treasure his friendship and our special working relationship. He was very committed to the Black press and just a selflow individual," said Mr. Jefferies, 76.

Red Doss, editor and publisher of the New Pittsburgh Courier, called Mr. Carter 'the embodiment of a classic Black newspaper man. He was committed to all facets of the publication and to Pittsburgh's Black community.

"Though I didn't know much about his personal life, I know he was easy to work with." Nr. Doss added.

In addition to journalism, Mr. Carter was a continuality activist who worked with and voluntoered for West End and North Side community appage.


Ms. Carter-Lowis said her brother suffered from blindness, Parkinson's discuss and dementia. "In the end, it was difficult for him, but he rever lost his sense for helping those who were in need – the underdog," she added.

Hr. Cartor, one-of-eight children, was preceded in death by his father, Surse Bramley, and his mother, Willie Mac Cartor Williams. He was once married and was the father of two sons, Joel Cartor (deceased) and Derrick Cartor. He had six grandchildren. He is also survived by a special friend, Vince-Magfield, also of Pittsburgh.

Mr. Carter had chosen cremation, but the family plans to celebrate his life in a special ceremony sometime next month, his sister said.


